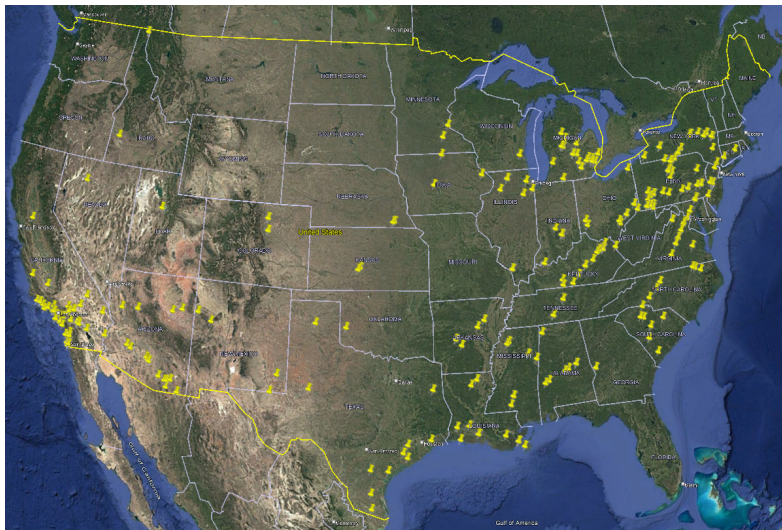


Reserve has been in the compression business since 1960 (First evacuation project completed in 1975).
